Anyone interested in exploring confirmation, please make contact with Louise. We are hoping there may be a small group keen to take this next step on their faith journey. Never think you are too old!

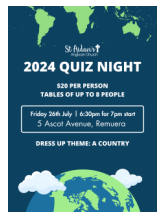
