BAPTISMS

Bible studies, fellowship and kai + the occasional off-site social event.

Meet: Every second Sunday, 4pm - 6pm downstairs in the youth room.

Volunteers help patients at Auckland Hospital to and from hospital church services from their hospital wards every second month on Sundays.

- Prison Ministry(Wiri Women's Prison)





We recommend using it for performances, dance or exercise classes, quiz nights, larger celebrations, prizegivings, exhibitions or markets, community gatherings, kids activities and kids parties.

For over a century, the people of St Aidan's have served the local and wider Auckland communities, as well as reaching out around the world with the good news of God in Jesus Christ. This mission and ministry has been achieved by the generosity of so many people. Such generosity is faith in action, and has been marked by the sharing of vision, talents, time, prayers, service and in the giving of financial resources.

Now well into its second century, St Aidan's community remains committed to living the love and justice of God in the world. This is the mission of the Gospel. Fulfilling that commitment continues to require our generosity. If you have come along to St Aidan's a few times and this feels like the place for you, then along with filling out the forms to officially join the parish and getting a name tag etc., you might be wondering about the ways that you can offer your support financially. As you participate in the community of St Aidan's, Vestry invites you to consider how you can be part of this generosity and, in particular, how you may be able to contribute financially to the work of this community.

GIVING

Individuals can claim a third of the donation back as a tax rebate, up to a maximum claim equal to their annual taxable income.

There are several ways you can financially support St Aidan's:

Automatic Payment: When an automatic transfer of money is made from your bank account to ours every week/month/quarter. You should be able to set this up via your internet or phone banking as a recurring transaction. If you do not have internet or phone banking and prefer to deal with your bank personally we can give you a form containing our details for you to complete and send to your bank. Please contact the office for this form. *If you give by automatic payment or internet banking, we are only able to keep a record if you have included a parish-issued reference number in your transaction details. Please contact the office to be given this reference number, which allows your giving to be as close to anonymous as possible.

Internet Banking: An electronic transfer is made through online banking. We can issue you with a reference number to quote in your transaction which allows us to issue you with a receipt.

Envelope Giving: If your giving varies each week, this would be the best option for you. Upon request, you are allocated a 'giving number' and a set of envelopes. You can then give anonymously by placing your envelope in the collection. If you give by envelope we will automatically keep a record of your giving so that at the end of the financial year we are able to send you a letter confirming the amount given. This can then be forwarded to your accountant or used in your personal tax return.

Cash Donations: Putting cash in the offering during one of our services.

Future Giving: Generations of St Aidan's parishioners have given so much to their church in so many ways. Without their faith and generosity of spirit, St Aidan's would not exist today. The St Aidan's Endowment Trust was established to help preserve their vision for the future.
